

# 1. Introduction

The COMUCA/USB is a interface, which connect a PC with the RS485 interface of Digitronic CamCon Cam Controller divices.

**Note:** If the software "DIGISOFT 2000 V4" and devices with RS485 interface is used, the COMUCA or the COMUCA / USB is always necessary !

# 2. Dimensions



#### 3. LED Status indicator

The red LED on the side of the CAM-BUS connector is used to display the CAM-BUS status:

- 1 \* flashing RS485 BUS is OK, COMUCA is CAM-BUS MASTER.
- 2 \* flashing RS485 BUS is OK, COMUCA is CAM-BUS SLAVE.
- 3 \* flashing Error, COMUCA / USB is in reconfiguration phase.
- 4 \* flashing COMUCA/USB is in Multiuser comminication mode or Flash Loader Mode for firmware update.

The yellow LED indicates the status to the PC:

Blinking Data are exchanged with the PC

# 4. Commisioning

Please observe the following sequence for commissioning:

- \* Connect the COMUCA to a free USB port on your PC and install the USB drivers. Please refer to chapter "2.1. Driver installation for COMUCA/USB" in Digisoft 2000 Manual. The LEDs on the COMUCA must now flash.
- \* Now connect the RS485 cable connections to the CamCon.
- **Note:** The ends of the RS485 data line must be terminated with resistors. Use Pins 1 + 4 of the DSUB connector. Should the terminating aktiv, connect 1 + 2 and pin 3 + 4 for each pin together.
- \* Switch power supply of the CamCon off and on, now the "Auto Contact Mode" of the CamCon is activ and the communication is established.
- **Note:** If the CamCon is already set to CamBus protocol, the interruption of the CamCon is Power supply no longer required. The factory setting of a CamCon is "Multiuser".
- \* Start the DIGISOFT 2000 program and configure the software. See this Chapter "2.3.2 Configuring the software" in the Digisoft 2000 WEB manual.

**Note:** A CamCon firmware from 10.1999 is necessary.

PC Interface	. USB 1.1, maximun cable length 1 meter.
CamCon Interface	. RS485, 38400 Baud, Digitronic CAM-BUS or Multiuser Protokoll, maximun cable length 100 meter.
Power supply	. 5VDC, Approx. 100mA via USB 1.1 interface.
Status Indicator	. 2 LEDs for function monitoring.
Dimensions	. See chapters "2. Dimensions".
Environmental conditions	.0 - + 50 ° C, max. 90% rel. Humidity (non-condensing).
